Here are the deadlines for what I want you to do and when you should do it. Just email me if anything else seems unclear, I was apparently not particularly reliable when I wrote the course description, but I'll try to fix it as best as I can.

Friday 14/2. You should have thought about Assignment 1 and be prepared to discuss it.
Monday 17/2. You shall hand in Assignment 2 no later than 09.00. In that assignment you will have use of Hughes & Leekam (2004), but you it is not so important that you read and understand it all – it is more background literature.

Thursday 20/2. You shall hand in Assignment 3 no later than 14.00. Note that this assignment is to write about Ross, Greene & House (1977) – the article that most students on this course find very difficult. Start on time!

Tuesday 25/2. You shall hand in Assignment 4 no later than 12.00. This assignment is about Ash (1955), but that is an easier paper to read than the previous ones.

Thursday 28/2. You shall hand in Assignment 5 no later than 13.00. Yaniv (2004) might be useful for this assignment, but you don't have to write about that article unless you want to.
